Then: Gather your team and decide a team name. Each team should have 16 paddlers and 1 drummer; try to have up to 3 reserves (whom you can include in one or other of the three heats). Please send us a team list in advance.

Payment: Send the entry fee of £50 by one month ahead, 18th June. Cheques should be payable to "Irvine Seagate Rotary". BACS payments can be made to the Royal Bank of Scotland, sort code 83-23-13, a/c 00180398 - the fee is non-refundable unless the event is cancelled due to weather.

Notes:

We encourage you to **raise funds** for a charity or organisation – for example, an average of £20 per team member would raise £400, and a £50 average would raise £1,000. Each team is responsible for its own fund-raising. No Dragon Boat experience is required. **Crew members** should be able to swim whilst wearing a buoyancy jacket (supplied). The minimum age is 12. Each participant must be in reasonable health. Each boat will have a professional helmsman supplied by the organisers.

On the day of the event, the full team must arrive for the **safety briefing** prior to its first race. The event will start at approx. 11:00 pm and the Grand Final and the Award Ceremony are scheduled for about 3 pm.
